The CHC43015 - Certificate IV in Ageing Support reflects the role of support workers who complete specialized tasks and functions in aged care services. They work either in residential, hospital or community based environments and are required to take responsibility for their own work within defined organization quidelines.

They will also be required to maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery. Workers will be required to demonstrate leadership and take responsibility for other team members.

Entry Requirement

- 16 years of age and above at the time of commencement of the course.
- Satisfactory completion of studies in applicant's home country equivalent to an Australian Year 10 qualification is required for entry into this course.
- Students may undergo language, literacy, and numeracy (LLN) to identify Language, Literacy and Numeracy capabilities at the time of Orientation (prior to commencing the courses).

*Mature age students (22+) may also be considered without the minimum education requirements. Each case will be reviewed individually to ascertain the capacity of the applicant to meet course

Students enrolling on the online program will be required to attend:

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- The online orientation
- The course is provided through Online Blended mode of delivery. It will be delivered over 1250 hours of delivery which will include online theory delivery, simulation-based training and assessment, as well as 120 hours of Professional Experience Placement (PEP).
