Entry Requirement

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification; however, applicants should demonstrate ability to perform tasks as required by the industry.

- 18 years of age and above at the time of commencement of the course
- Successful completion of an Australian Year 12 course or equivalent

Note: Mature age students (22+) may also be considered without the minimum education requirements. Each case will be reviewed individually to ascertain the capacity of the applicant to meet qualification requirements.

Students enrolling on the online program will be required to attend:

- The online orientation
- The course is provided through Online Blended mode of delivery. It will be delivered over 1505 hours including theory delivery, formative activities (925 Hours), simulation-based training, summative assessment (155 hours) and 400 hours of professional experience placement (PEP).
